## Business

## Program

Captain Mike McCord, Acting Assistant Chief of UTA Police, presented a program about UTA campus security. Property crime is the most common on campus. Property crime requires three elements, a criminal, a victim and opportunity. To prevent the crime, take away the opportunity by not leaving valuables unattended. If a property crime occurs it is good to have records of valuables such as serial numbers, photographs and documentation. Robberies occur occur on campus in situations in which the victim is distracted. If robbery occurs, give the robber what is wanted. Captain McCord reminded attendees of the advice "If you see something, say something." He said, if a situation seemed suspicious it should be reported as soon as possible. The phone number for emergencies on campus is 817-272-3003. There are also about 300 emergency call boxes on campus the directly contact the dispatcher.

Questions were answered. When asked, Captain McCord responded there were no crime centers in the City of Arlington. Personal security escorts are available any time on campus if requested. 40 hours of continuing training is required for campus offices every 2 years. Concealed carry will be legal for licensed gun owners on campus beginning August 1, 2016 although open carry will continue illegal. The meeting was adjourned.
