**T**he College of Nursing and Health Innovation (CONHI) at UT Arlington is a center of excellence in health care education and research. Its faculty, staff, and students strive to **improve the human condition** through training and working as health care professionals, through research in basic and applied health science, and through service to the North Texas community and beyond.

As the **largest producer of baccalaureate-educated nurses in the state** and the **largest nonprofit college of nursing in the U.S.**, CONHI is helping meet the critical demand for nurses. The college enrolls more than **20,000 students every year** and offers a variety of degree programs and certifications to help them prepare for their successful futures.

Recently, both undergraduate- and graduate-level certificates focusing on health informatics, an important and fast-growing field, were added, along with a graduate certificate for diversity and equity in public health. CONHI also launched the **Center for Rural Health and Nursing** to enhance access to health care for Texas' rural communities and support efforts to improve rural nursing education.
