Practicum education is fundamental to the school's mission. Students complete **internships at over 400 local agencies**, contributing about **540,000 hours of service each year**—valued at an estimated **\$17 million in economic impact.**

The school's faculty are active scholars, publishing more than **200 peer-reviewed articles annually**, placing UTA in the **94th percentile for social work research productivity nationally.** It is this research and service that continues to help changemakers make a difference right here in DFW and in communities across the country.
