About the AIM Instructor Portal

The AIM Instructor Portal is designed for instructors to be able to manage accommodations for students with disabilities who are enrolled in their courses all in one place.

Benefits of the Instructor Portal:

- Single Sign On using UTA credentials
- Review SAR Center Faculty Notification Letters at any time
- See all registered SAR Center students and their accommodations at-a-glance
- Complete Testing Agreements for students using the Alternative Testing Center
- Copy Testing Agreements to other course sections
- See student's scheduled exams and their status
- See Alternative Format books requested by students
- Upload exams



Accessing the Instructor Portal

- Visit https://www.bachelor.accessiblelearning.com/uta to access the Instructor Portal.
- Log in with UTA credentials.
- Reminders and announcements can be found on the authentication page.
- Read and agree to the FERPA statement.
- Click "Continue to View Student Accommodations" to view a list of your students that have requested accommodations.



The Overview Page

- After signing in, you will be directed to the Overview Page.
- The Overview page lists the names of the students in your courses who have requested accommodations.
- Beside each student's name are categories for different accommodations such as the ATC, Notetaking, Alternative Format Books, and Deaf and/or Hard of Hearing. There will be a "Yes" under the accommodation if they have requested it.
- Click on the student's name to send an email directly to them.
- Click view by the student's name to view their Faculty Notification Letter for more detailed information about the student's accommodations.





Course Syllabus Tab


- Allows instructors to upload class syllabifor easy student use.
- Preferred formats:
 - Microsoft Word (DOC or DOCX)
 - PDF Document scan with 300 DPI or less

Other acceptable formats:

- Rich Text File (RTF)
- Text File (TXT)

Note:


 Microsoft PPT (PPT or PPTX) are not recommended due to size.






Alternative Testing Tab

- From this tab instructors can create, copy, and modify testing agreements.
- Instructors can also view which students have scheduled exams, the status of those exams, and upload exam files.
- Once exams have been completed and uploaded by ATC staff, the exams will be available for viewing under the Completed Exams Files tab in the top right corner.

Alternative Formats Tab


- This tab allows instructors to view a list of books that students have requested.

Notetaking Services Tab


- Instructors can view assigned notetakers, if applicable
